1. The enclosure is forwarded, as a preliminary report, in  
order that pertinent information on the MIDWAY ISLAND action may be av-  
ailable to you at the earliest possible time. They were, in most cases  
prepared on Monday, June 8, 1942, at MIDWAY, and brought out, by air, by  
the undersigned on June 9, 1942. Statements of the five (5) rear seat  
gunners, and of Captain John F. Carey (VMF-221), Captain Herbert T. Her-  
rill (VMF-221), and Captain Richard L. Blain, (VMSB-241), all of whom are  
in the U.S. Naval Hospital, Pearl Harbor, having been evacuated by air  
from MIDWAY, were obtained while they were patients.

2. Major Lofton R. Henderson and Major Floyd B. Parks were  
the respective Squadron Commanders of Marine Scout-Bombing Squadron 241  
and Marine Fighting Squadron 221. Both failed to return to base from  
their first mission.

3. A more detailed report will be forwarded when prepared.
